Happy September, Grace Wesleyan Family!

We made it through the summer, and schools have started up again for another year! For some of us, it is a time when vacations are over, kids and grandkids are back into their usual school routines, and it is often when many of us take a look at what things in the life of the church we are going to engage with. Will you join a Bible study this fall? Our pastor's Bible study on Tuesday evening has proven to be fun, informative, and a great way to learn about scripture in ways that are making all of those in attendance better at understanding how scripture matters to Christians NOW. Will you become more engaged in one of our church's ministries? The Helping Hands Food Pantry is partnering with Hope South Florida (two of our primary ministries!) to help those facing food insecurity in our local community. They need people to gather, sort, and deliver the food that comes into our church. The hungry in our area are in ever greater need these days. They need our help!

We started a men's group last year, and a women's ministry is kicking off with a one-day retreat in October. There is also a specific study in which some members of our church are seeking to know how the evangelical movement started by John Wesley became blessed by God and ended up being the most successful movement in modern times. Whatever you think you might be interested in, we probably have something for you. I invite you to take a look at your life and see what it is you can get involved with to enhance your walk with Christ, learn more about your faith heritage, and truly become the hands, feet, and heart of Christ to a world we know needs him more than ever. Where can *you* become more involved?

Normally we associate "new beginnings" with New Year's resolutions or Spring, but in the normal calendar of our lives, it is fall...post-Labor Day...when we most often begin new regimens; we start a class, we join a service work. We look for things to keep busy with after the summer with family vacations, outdoor activities that wind down, or to perhaps fill the time voids that result when the youth in our lives return to their routines. What will be *your* "new beginning" this fall? I hope you seriously consider one and then make it happen!

In the coming weeks, we will be moving forward with getting out of our "church walls" and meeting our neighbors. We are going to introduce our church to the community in a very personal way. We will not be going out to preach Jesus. We are going to invite people to come to our church so that perhaps they will meet Christ in our midst. God through the Holy Spirit will move the hearts of people we meet, not us. It is God who leads people to faith. We are simply going to let them know that there is a new place for them to worship, meet Christians, and hear the Word of God as found in Holy Scripture preached and taught. If we love Jesus (I believe we do), and if we love our church (I believe we do), then it is up to us to let people know our church is here and that the heart of and for Jesus can be found in it!

It is that heart...a heart for Christ and a heart for his church...that leads us to spread the gospel as best we can. For us at Grace Wesleyan, that means that we go tell people we are here. Our efforts this fall will culminate in a special event we will have in December (we are in the planning stages of an outdoor event for families).
