PASTOR'S MOMENT

A message from our Senior Pastor, Rev. Myron Rhodes, Jr. pastor@gracewesleyan.org

Dear Grace Wesleyan Family,

Another year is upon us as 2022 is now in the rear-view mirror. Last year was a significant year for Grace Wesleyan. In February I was ordained as your pastor, and we consecrated Mr. Tony Ash as our Lay Leader. The pandemic no longer kept us from fellowship and meeting and our church began to grow beyond the original founders to include many more people. By the end of 2022 we were experiencing over 200 unique visits a month! God is growing our membership and new faces show up weekly!

We began the year with a study on "Becoming a Contagious Christian." Well over half of our members attended the six-week study where we learned how to easily tell our "Jesus story" and how to share the Gospel with others. We learned that often it is easier to get to know others over a cookout or a meal before we can invite them to church. The focus of the messages all year was on discipleship.

In November we walked through our neighborhoods knocking on doors to introduce our church to those close to us in proximity. In December we had our first Family Fun Day at Bayview Park where we met over 250 families and kids from our local area. It was a great time with a bounce house (it was filled with kids from set up at noon to break down at 4pm!), live music with Freddie Colloca and a gifted group of teens who played great music for us, and we distributed 200 Chick Fil A meals! It was a fun time in which we were able to introduce ourselves to people we would not have met otherwise.

As we move into 2023, the new emphasis is to turn ourselves outward to try to share the light that God has shined in our hearts. As the world suddenly (or so it seems) now is seeing prayer on TV as sports teams openly pray in the wake of the Damar Hamlin incident, and even sportscasters are praying on TV in prime time, we have an opportunity to be more open about our faith. We should be encouraged even more to be open about our faith because it appears that what we have known all along (i.e., the world needs faith), is becoming recognized. My word for this year is Emmanuel, God with us, not because he suddenly is, but because he always was and we can boldly step forward with the knowledge of that.

This year, we are being more intentional as a church to reach out, speak out, and let our light shine so that those in our community can see that Grace Wesleyan is a place where Christian fellowship is found, celebrated, and lived. Our task is great, for sure, but our God is big enough to help us be what he has told us we are: Children of God, Disciples of Christ, and sinners. While we walk with the humbleness that comes from recognizing our need for forgiveness and transformation in Christ, may we also walk with boldness as those who have found a way to be in relationship with our Creator!

I pray that God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit move you to the next steps in your walk with them so that you may experience the joy, hope, love, and peace that Christ wants for us. Challenges and crucibles come, but God is always with us.

Emmanuel, my friends, God is indeed with us!
