Dear Grace Wesleyan Family,

February is an exciting month in the annual life of our church! On February 8, 2020, Grace Wesleyan met for its very first worship service. Back then it was called the Wesleyan Fellowship Group as we had not officially named our church. However, the hearts of God's people were confident in the move to begin a new worship community here in north Broward County. One year later, on February 6, 2021, I began as your first full-time pastor, and shortly thereafter we adopted the name of Grace Wesleyan. The last two years have brought some challenges, but the rewards and joy of being a part of a new, dedicated, and vibrant body of Christ has far outweighed those challenges.

We have nearly doubled in size in the last two years. The growth has been slow and steady, and we may have not noticed it so much, but if you look around, there are many faces that attend every week (or nearly so!) that were not with us when we started 3 years ago. God has been adding to our numbers weekly! Our Pastor's Bible study has enjoyed a very high percentage of the membership participating. Our Monday evening Men's Accountability Group has been growing lately as well. And, our Wesley study on the 1st and 3rd Thursday evenings has experienced some significant increase in our understanding of what it meant to be a Christian in the Wesleyan Methodist tradition when things were growing and obviously blessed by God all those years ago.

Good things are happening at Grace Wesleyan, and we are seeking to grow our presence in the local community. Our first move in that direction was held in December when we had our Family Fun Day at Bayview Park. Our next move is to hire an associate pastor to grow our young adult ministry. As part of that effort, we will have a guest, Franklyn, deliver the sermon to us on Saturday and Sunday February 11th & 12th. We hope you are able to join us at one of those services to hear Franklyn bring us the Word of God.

The Grace Wesleyan Women are kicking off their new study *Restless* by Jennie Allen. It is an eight-week study that contains a DVD to lead discussion and a workbook to guide the learning. The study begins on Monday, February 6th at 7:00pm and it is intended that couples can now participate with the men attending the Men's Group and the ladies attending the Women's Group on Monday evenings at 7pm! Other planned events for the ladies are the upcoming Women's Tea in May that will feature a well-known guest speaker (details to follow) and a "scripture picture" painting class on March 4th. Our music program is evolving, and the band that played for us at the Family Fun Day will be joining us in worship on Saturday evenings soon! Mr. Joe Kohler will become our full-time accompanist on Sunday mornings beginning February 5th, and we are actively seeking persons to be a part of the effort to establish a praise team of singers and other people who are interested in the Sunday morning music program. Finally, not only is February our Founder's Month, it is also the month in which we will acknowledge those who have joined our church in the last year.
