Mother's Day is Sunday, May 14th! According to History.com (https://www.history.com/topics/holidays/mothersday);

"The origins of Mother's Day as celebrated in the United States date back to the 19th century. In the years before the <u>Civil War</u>, Ann Reeves Jarvis of <u>West Virginia</u> helped start "Mothers' Day Work Clubs" to teach local women how to properly care for their children.

These clubs later became a unifying force in a region of the country still divided over the Civil War. In 1868 Jarvis organized "Mothers' Friendship Day," at which mothers gathered with former Union and Confederate soldiers to promote reconciliation.

Another precursor to Mother's Day came from the abolitionist and suffragette <u>Julia Ward Howe</u>. In 1870 Howe wrote the "Mother's Day Proclamation," a call to action that asked mothers to unite in promoting world peace. In 1873 Howe campaigned for a "Mother's Peace Day" to be celebrated every June 2.

Other early Mother's Day pioneers include Juliet Calhoun Blakely, a <u>temperance</u> activist who inspired a local Mother's Day in Albion, <u>Michigan</u>, in the 1870s. The duo of Mary Towles Sasseen and Frank Hering, meanwhile, both worked to organize a Mothers' Day in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Some have even called Hering "the father of Mothers' Day."

More phone calls are made on Mother's Day than any other day of the year.

Greetings, Grace Family!

Each time I sit down to write this monthly letter, I am amazed at how fast the time flies. For many of us, this serves only to remind us of how fast we are approaching the end of our days on this earth. Good news! Eternity is a VERY long time, and since we are eternity people, our hope lies very far beyond the limits of time here on earth. Jesus has risen, and he has gone to his (ours, too!) Father's house to prepare a place for us! These words of Christ carry the very best news for all those who claim Jesus and follow his commands to be obedient! This past Easter we had the largest Sunday attendance in our young church's life. We experienced a very nice music program, and Easter Sunday felt like it has not in some years for many of us. Praise God for the blessings of a growing church and the presence of the Holy Spirit in our midst! We have new faces showing up nearly every week, and God is adding to our numbers!

As we grow and diversify our offerings, I am happy to announce that we are launching a new study/video series in the coming weeks. Many of you have watched some of The Chosen episodes, and we have acquired Seasons 1-3. We will launch a study in which we will watch the 24 episodes (so far!) in order, one per week. Each episode runs between 35-45 minutes. We will watch, then discuss what we have seen/heard. Each session is planned to be one hour, and we will do our best to honor the one-hour time. The study will be held each Tuesday at 7:00pm in one of the upstairs classrooms located at the top of the stairs adjacent to our entrance on the side of the church. We expect to start the series in late May, and are coordinating it with the completion of our regular Pastor's Bible study that is finishing up the Book of Matthew, so stay tuned for the announcement of the exact start.

Also, on the 20th of this month, the Grace Wesleyan Women are having their Ladies Tea. Annette, Kathy, Sandi, and Janice are organizing and putting on this event that I assure you will be a fantastic time for the ladies! I do hope that all of the ladies of Grace Wesleyan will come and invite their friends and neighbors, even if they attend other churches, to what is sure to be a marvelous afternoon! There will be a guest speaker, music by our own Aijeleth Lee, food, prizes, and, of course, tea!

We also have an opportunity to partner and sponsor Love Life South Florida through their <u>Ride for Life</u>! that kicks off on May 4th, the National Day of Prayer. Love Life only does one major fund-raiser a year, and this year it is the Ride for Life. We are sponsoring Rev. Frank Trotta and his team, who have pledged to ride the 3400 miles as a group. I have set a goal for us to sponsor them at 50 cents per mile, and the event is spread out over a 60-days. Each week through July 2nd, we will have a chance to make an above and beyond donation toward our goal. We will post each week our progress so everyone can see how we are doing! This is an important ministry, as we believe that God knits together every person in their mother's womb to carry out a special purpose in God's Kingdom here on earth. It is a Christian duty to pray for, support, and carry the word that we care about the lives that God is knitting together. Each person can do their part, large or small, and God will honor our efforts. I ask that you prayerfully consider what God is laying on your heart concerning this ministry, whether it is to pray, walk, or give. Any or all of these things are needed. Join me as we support this ministry in our neighborhood that supports those women and men who sometimes think the only choice they have, is to terminate what God has created. It is not about being anti-abortion. That is a political issue. It is about being FOR the life that God loves them and there is a way to live into God's grace even after a difficult decision.

As we seek ways to be the hands, feet, and heart of Christ to our community, may we have the courage and fortitude to walk in the Spirit of God, even in the face of the selfishness of the world that does not honor servanthood and discipleship to Christ. May God empower us to impact our local community!
