It is an exciting time to be a part of Grace Wesleyan Church, Fort Lauderdale!

On this July 1st we celebrate the arrival of our new pastor, Rev. Franklyn Rodriguez and his wife, Noelle, and their 5-yearold son, Lucas!

WELCOME, FRANKLYN, NOELLE, AND LUCAS!

I do hope you will make it a point to introduce yourself to Franklyn and his family as soon as it is possible for you. He is a highly motivated and *EXCITED* disciple of Christ and he will be a huge part of the growing presence of Grace Wesleyan in the Fort Lauderdale community! He is an experienced church planter, and his primary focus for us will be to launch the home church ministry of Grace Wesleyan with an emphasis on gaining new faces and young adults and families! He has already told me of inviting Uber drivers and persons he is meeting in the neighborhoods as he finds his way around our local community...and he has been here only three days!

Many have been praying for a Wesleyan revival of the Christian church in this place. When we at Grace Wesleyan surrendered our ideas of what church had to be, God began to reveal to us what he planned for us to be. He led us all to a new church home. He brought Annette and I here to be a part of this church family. And now he has brought us a bi-lingual young man who will undoubtedly lead many to our church that will grow us and shape us for years to come. May we always be mindful that it is the Church of Jesus Christ, not our church. Jesus will bring the people. Our job is to love them and welcome them. Our continued blessing and grace are directly tied to our love and obedience to the laws of God, the commands of Jesus, and our loving our entire community as we love ourselves. I pray we can always be getting better at doing all the above!
